

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
TOWN OF WHATELY

Pursuant to the within warrant a special meeting of the Town of Whately held at the Whately Elementary School at 273 Long Plain Road was called to order on Tuesday, October 18, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. by Moderator Paul M. Fleuriel, Jr. Town Clerk, Lynn M. Sibley, read the Constable's return of the warrant. There were seven voters in attendance.

Article 1. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

Voted under Article 1 that the Town transfer the sum of **\$9,500** from Free Cash to be added to the \$35,000 appropriated at the April 27, 2010 Annual Town Meeting to the Fire Department Roof and Insulation Account # 001-220-5800.

Article 2. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

Voted under Article 2 that the town transfer the sum of **\$1,200** from Free Cash to the Town Building Operations Account #001-192-5400 for the purchase of interior storm windows for the Center School building.

Article 3. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

Voted under Article 3 that the town declare the 1961 Adams Motor Grader as surplus property and authorize the Selectmen to dispose of the grader through any method that they deem to be in the best interest of the town.

Article 4. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

Voted under article 4 that the town declare a recently cut down unique maple tree as surplus property and authorize the Tree Warden to sell through sealed bids.

There being no further business and upon motion made and seconded, it was voted to adjourn without day at 6:08 p.m.
