The presiding officer then removed the ballots from the box and caused them to be counted one by one, and announced the whole number of ballots cast to be 204. Included in the count were five absentee ballots. There were no spoiled or provisional ballots. The ballots having been duly sorted and counted were recorded and declared in open meeting to be as set forth in the official record. All Ballots were placed in the ballot storage box and sealed with stickers.


