

## Special State Primaries – December 8, 2009

Polls opened at 7:00 a.m. on a sunny but cold winter day. At the opening of polls the temperature was in the low 20's rising to the low 40's by afternoon. Polls closed at 8:00 p.m.

At the opening of the polls and before any ballots were cast, the Ballot Box register indicated 000; and at the close of the polls the Ballot Box register indicated 241. The bell on the ballot box failed to ring a number of times but the counter did accept the ballots. Included in this total were 8 democratic absentee ballots. No republican or libertarian absentee ballots were received. Two overseas absentee ballots were sent but never received. The officers in charge of the voting lists counted and announced the whole number of names checked on said list to be 241. The number of Democratic voters on the list was 203. The number of Republican voters on the list was 38. There were no Libertarian votes. The presiding officer then removed the ballots from the box and caused them to be counted one by one, and announced the whole number of ballots cast as 241. The number of Democratic ballots removed from the ballot box was 203 and Republic ballots 38. The ballots having been duly sorted and counted were recorded and declared in open meeting to be as set forth in the official record. Count completed at 8:30 p.m. Ballots were sealed in a plastic tote with a security strip marked 0329024 along with three paper stickers. Canvas of votes:
