**COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS**

**Franklin, SS.**

To either of the Constables of the Town of Whately in the County of Franklin, GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the **Whately Elementary School at 273 Long Plain Road in Whately on Tuesday, April 27** next, at **seven-ten o'clock in the afternoon**, then and there to act on the following articles:

**Article 1.** To see if the town will vote to transfer from the Stabilization Account the sum of \$35,000 to cover the cost to replace the roof and insulation on the Fire Station or take any other action relative thereto.

**Article 2.** To see if the town will vote to transfer \$3,000 from Account 001-450-5820 Water Lightning Protection to a new account to cover the costs of an electronic chlorine monitoring system required by law effective July 1, 2010 or take any other action relative thereto.

**Article 3.** To see if the town will vote to transfer the sum of \$15,000 from Account number 001-423-5400 Winter Roads to Account number 001-914-5400 Group Insurance to cover the cost of additional insurance plans in FY10 or take any other action relative thereto.


