**Question One:**

Shall the Town of Whately be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to pay costs of purchasing a pumper truck and related pumper equipment for the Fire Department, including the payment of all costs incidental and related thereto?


and provided, further, that said question shall be deemed approved if a majority of the persons voting thereon shall vote "yes".

HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting, as aforesaid.


