

Annual Town Election – June 12, 2012

Polls opened at 10:00 a.m. on a cloudy spring morning. By afternoon light rain fell. Temperatures were in the 60's. Polls closed at 7:00 p.m.

At the opening of the polls, and before any ballots were cast, the Ballot Box register indicated 000; and at the close of the polls the Ballot Box register indicated 120. The officers in charge of the voting lists counted and announced the whole number of names checked on said list to be 120. Five absentee ballots were cast. The Presiding Officer (Warden) then removed the ballots from the box and caused them to be counted one by one, and announced the whole number of ballots cast to be 120. The ballots having been duly sorted and counted were recorded and declared in open meeting to be as set forth in the official record. Upon completion of counting, ballots were secured and sealed with two zip strips marked 0329037 and 0329095. There were 1112 registered voters including inactive voters at the time of this election. Count completed at 7:45 p.m.
