- 1. <u>Whately Renewables Request for a Certificate of Compliance for Solar Farm on Christian Lane</u>. A site visit was conducted on August 21, 2019. The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to issue a Certificate of Compliance without conditions.
- <u>Request for a Certificate of Compliance submitted by Justin Baronas for renovation of a garage at 140</u> <u>Conway Road</u>. A site visit was conducted on November 17, 2019. The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to issue a Certificate of Compliance without conditions.
- 3. J.D. Ross addressed the Commission to discuss his plans to install a swimming pool and small shed in an area of lawn at his house on State Road. He described the site and the location of the pool and shed. The pool will be located within buffer zone, approximately 75 feet from a bordering vegetated wetland. After a brief discussion, Mr. Ross was informed that his project would be considered a minor activity under the MA Wetlands Protection Act regulations and, therefore, he would not need to file anything with the Conservation Commission.
- 4. The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to accept minutes from the October 16<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- 5. The Commission reviewed the mail.
