The proposed subdivision would include senior housing, and would serve as a demonstration

project for sustainable development through the use of open space and cluster developments, congregate housing, renewable energy, and conservation areas and trails. Discussion points included zoning and flood map designations. The board recommended that Mr. Stiebel and Ms. Gees contact Scott Jackson of the Conservation Commission, and Brent White of White Engineering, whose firm has handled other projects for the town. It was also recommended that they talk with Richard Tillberg of the Housing Committee about building affordable housing. The board will research the cluster housing regulations.
