Notice is hereby given that the Zoning Board of Appeals of Whately will hold a public hearing on Thursday, March 3, 2022 at 6:40 PM. On January 6, 2022 Greenjeans Farms, LLC was granted a Special Permit by the Zoning Board of Appeals of Whately to cultivate marijuana in greenhouses on premises located in the AR/1 and AR/2 zones at Long Plain Farm, 149 Christian Ln. and owned by Scott and Wayne M. Hutkoski.

On February 14, 2022 Greenjeans Farms, LLC applied for a Special Permit to allow additional time to reconstruct the damaged greenhouse which was approved for Indoor cultivation of marijuana as part of the January 6, 2022 decision. Application for the Special Permit is to be considered under the provisions of the Whately Zoning Bylaws as provided by M.G.L. c. 40A.

The hearing will take place virtually via Zoom. The rules of decorum for a public hearing remain in effect and the Chairperson will seek comments from the public when appropriate to do so.
