Notice is hereby given that the Zoning Board of Appeals of Whately will continue a public hearing on Thursday, June 3, 2021 at 8:00 pm. The hearing will take place virtually via Zoom. The rules of decorum for a public hearing remain in effect and the Chairperson will seek comments from the public when appropriate to do so.

Stephen Herbert, of Urban Grown, Inc., has applied for a special permit to cultivate marijuana on premises zoned Commercial, owned by Ryszard Brynda, Kristine Jordan, and Wiesia Nye of Deerfield, and located at State Rd. (Map 32, Lot 6). Also requested is a waiver, as described in Whately Bylaws section 171-28.6, C., 5., to allow reduction of the required 500 ft setback from a recreation area (Tri-Town Beach) to 300 ft. Application for the special permit is to be considered under the provisions of the Whately Zoning Bylaws as provided by M.G.L. c. 40A.
