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# May 12 2021 UPVVSD Advisory Board Meeting Minutes

-Meeting called to order at 1804 by Chairman Dave Gendron, Rule of Necessity passed due to Covid to accept 8 votes for majority, same as Oct 2020 meeting

Towns Present via Webex Phone: Ashfield, Bernardston, Colrain, Greenfield, heath, Montague, New Salem, Shutesbury

- -Approval of prior meeting Minutes: motion by Heath, seconded by Shutesbury, votes passes unanimously
- **-New Business** Motion to keep elected officers the same by New Salem, seconded by Colrain until fall meeting, passes unanimously due to covid
- -Future meetings by Webex rescinded due to changing covid restriction, future meetings in person
- -Director Niejadlik discuses new VA Telehealth site and purpose on location. Dave Gendron asks about transportation into office for non-drivers. This is a ongoing discussion with VA and DAV. Dave Gendron ask for update once determined. Wayne Hatchey(New Salem) offers to help for vets in his area that may need ride in.
- **-Old business** Tim Niejadlik presents 90 day district report for towns; this was part of packet handed out for meeting. Motion to accept by Shutesbury, second by New Salem, report accepted unanimously.
- -Next meeting date set for Oct 13, 2021 at 6pm UPVVSD offices
- -Motion to adjourn by Shutesbury at 1823, seconded by New Salem, meeting adjourned



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## 4th QTR FY21 Updates for UPVVSD (Apr 1-Jun 30 2021)

Below are some highlights for activities in the district this past quarter:

- ➤ All staff that are eligible (3 of 4) fully vaccinated for COVID. We continue to keep full hours. Still have some towns and COAs closed. This limits outreach. However we are back to Montague COA, Northfield Town Hall, Deerfield Town Hall (instead of COA) and Ashfield Town Hall.
- Chris Demars finally fully up and running as a NSO. All new VA claims being submitted directly instead of through Massachusetts office
- ➤ Laura Thorne continues to serve as certified SHINE councilor, helping numerous veterans and dependents with health insurance
- ➤ Massachusetts installed new software for Ch115 program. This was a disaster and continues to cause more work for staff. This was not a well thought out rollout on the state side!!
- ➤ District kicked off VA Telehealth Center with open house, bookings just started in August, some hesitancy on the VA providers to use. This is being addressed with outreach and VA CWM Director Duane Gill. DAV will bring in clients along with Wayne Hatchey for vets out his way.
- ➤ District re-certified all Ch 115 clients for the first six months of FY22 as per state law (approx 88 clients). Expenditures continue to go down due to alternative monies and deaths or moving
- District purchased and distributed 93 gross of cemetery flags for Memorial Day and over 100 Veteran gravesite flag holders. Purchased approx 50 US flags and POW flags for towns
- ▶ Between April 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup> the district completed the following Federal VA claims: 20 new VA claims for compensation, 5 claims for higher rating, 4 claims for appeal/review, 3 claim for D.I.C., 3 claims for VA burial assistance, 10 claims for VA footstones, 2 records requests to the Archives in St Louis, 3 applications for the MA Annuity and 4 tax abatement applications
