After our conversation earlier, here is the base quote for the irrigation at the ball fields.

\$27,300.00

Please note that this number is just an estimate, as we do not know how much water the well will produce. Also costs of materials, labor, etc., so they may change. This price also does not include the mainline and wire as the well is in place and the location of the irrigation controller is decided. As I mentioned earlier I recommend the drilling for the well needed, as they did the one for us at Hopkins Academy here in Hadley. Any questions, please
