In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the **Whately Elementary School, 273 Long Plain Road, Whately on the twenty-eighth day of April** next, at **six forty-five in the evening**, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds the sum of \$13,631 to be added to Account # 001-320-5410 Smith Vocational Tuition to pay for additional expenses or take any other action relative thereto.
