Before the election all unvoted ballots were counted. Democratic ballots included 902 Official Ballots, 250 Absentee Ballots, and 50 Automark ballots. Republican ballots included 200 Official Ballots, 100 Absentee Ballots and 50 Automark ballots. Libertarian ballots included 100 Official Ballots, 50 Absentee Ballots and 50 Automark ballots.

There were 1175 registered voters including inactive voters. Three Specially Qualified voters were sent democratic ballots and only one was returned.

At the opening of the polls and before any ballots were cast, the Ballot Box register indicated 000; and at the close of the polls the Ballot Box register indicated 440. Three UOCAVA ballots were counted separately making a total of 443. Included in this total were 28 Democratic absentee ballots and 1 Republican Absentee ballot. There were no Libertarian Absentee ballots. The officers in charge of the voting lists counted and announced the whole number of names checked on said list to be 440. The number of Democratic voters on the list was 354. The number of Republican voters on the list was 86. There were no Libertarian ballots cast. The presiding officer then removed the ballots from the box and caused them to be counted one by one, and announced the whole number of ballots cast as 440. The number of Democratic ballots removed from the ballot box was 354 and Republican ballots 86. The ballots having been duly sorted and counted were recorded and declared in open meeting to be as set forth in the official record. Count completed at 10:30 p.m. Voted ballots were sealed in a plastic tote with 2 security strips marked 0329008 and 0329054 along with 1 signed paper sticker. Unvoted ballots were sealed in a separate tote and secured with strip # 0329023. There were nine inactive voter who completed an Affidavit of Current and Continuous Residency.
