

**Town of Whately
Special Town Meeting Warrant
June 25, 2012**

COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

Franklin, SS.

To either of the Constables of the Town of Whately in the County of Franklin, GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the **Whately Elementary School at 273 Long Plain Road in Whately on Monday, June 25th** next, at **six-thirty o'clock in the afternoon**, then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to accept for highway purposes the two parcels at the end of Poplar Hill Road from Peter B. Crisci containing approximately 2,080 square feet and from the Trustees of The Smith College containing approximately 3,972 square feet, both as shown on the Plan of Land in Whately, Massachusetts, Prepared for Smith College dated October 11, 2011 or take any other action relative.

Recommended by the Selectmen

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds to a special account a sum not to exceed \$2,000 for damages to be paid for an easement on Poplar Hill Road or take any other action relative thereto.

Recommended by the Selectmen

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of \$25,000 for continued engineer and survey costs for the Mill River Stabilization project or take any other action relative thereto.

Recommended by the Selectmen

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of \$5,000 to the FY 13 Police & Fire Insurance Account # 001-914-5440 to be added to the amount appropriated at the April 24, 2012 Annual Town Meeting or take any other action relative thereto.

Recommended by the Selectmen


