**COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS**

**Franklin, SS.**

To either of the Constables of the Town of Whately in the County of Franklin, GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the **Whately Town Office Building, #4 Sandy Lane, Whately, on the Seventeenth day of November** next, at **seven in the evening**, then and there to act on the following articles:

**ARTICLE 1:** To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of **\$188,000.00** from the Stabilization Fund to be added to Account # 001-450-5840, Emergency Mill River Stabilization, to pay the expenses related to the Mill River Stabilization Project, or take any other action relative thereto.

*2/3 vote required*

**ARTICLE 2:** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds, the sum of **\$30,000** to be added to Account #001-192-5400, Town Building Operations, to pay for the costs associated with the insurance and operation of Town owned buildings, or take any other action relative thereto.

*Majority vote required*




Hereof fail not, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.


