Special Town Meeting Warrant

**COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS**

**Franklin, SS.**

To either of the Constables of the Town of Whately in the County of Franklin, GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the **Whately Elementary School, 273 Long Plain Road in Whately on Tuesday, the 4<sup>th</sup> of December** next, at **seven o'clock in the afternoon**, then and there to act on the following article:

**Article 1.** To see if the town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of **\$64,000** to the Emergency Mill River Stabilization Account (Account # 001-450-5850) for additional engineering and permitting costs for this project or take any other action relative thereto.

**Article 2.** To see if the town will vote to transfer from the Enterprise Revenue Account to the Water Department Operations Account #610-450-5400 the sum of **\$4,095** to cover the cost of the Water Storage Tank Inspection and Cleaning or take any other action relative thereto.

**Article 3.** To see if the town will vote to transfer from Free Cash to the Ambulance Account #001-232-5400 the sum of **\$1,700** and further to approve the payment of a Fiscal Year 2012 bill from OCI Software or to take any other action relative. (9/10<sup>th</sup> vote)

**Article 4.** To see if the town will vote to establish a demand fee of \$10 for Police Department detail bills that are over 30 days late or take any other action relative thereto.






Hereof fail not, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
