At the opening of the polls, and before any ballots were cast, the Ballot Box register indicated 000 and was declared empty; and at the close of the polls the Ballot Box register indicated 558. There were 1125 voters eligible to vote in this election. The officers in charge of the voting lists counted and announced the whole number of names checked on said list to be 558. The presiding officer then removed the ballots from the box and caused them to be counted one by one, and announced the whole number of ballots cast to be 558 . Included in the count were 24 absentee ballots. Three absentee ballots requested were not returned by the close of polls. There were two provisional ballots. One was counted because the voter registration form was found in the Clerk's office and was dated prior to the close of registration but had not been entered into the computer. The other provisional ballot was not counted because it was determined by the RMV that the applicant checked no on the box to register to vote. The ballots having been duly sorted and counted were recorded and declared in open meeting to be as set forth in the official record. All Ballots were placed in the black ballot storage box and sealed with 2 paper seals. Count completed at 8:30 p.m.
