At the opening of the polls, and before any ballots were cast, the Ballot Box register indicated 000; and at the close of the polls the Ballot Box register indicated 662. There are 1,086 Active Registered Voters and 81 Inactive voters on the voter lists. Included in total votes were 26 Democrat absentee ballots, 10 Republican absentee ballots and no Green Rainbow or United Independent Party ballots. One additional Democratic absentee ballot was requested but was not returned prior to the close of the polls. At the close of polls the officers in charge of the voting lists counted and announced the whole number of names check on said list to be 662. The number of Democratic voters was 466. The number of Republican voters was 193. The number of Green-Rainbow voters was 3. There were no United Independent Party voters. The presiding officer then removed the ballots from the box and caused them to be counted one by one, and announced the whole number of ballots cast as 662 . The ballots having been duly sorted and counted were recorded and declared in open meeting to be as set forth in the official record. The count was completed at 9:45 p.m. All ballots were placed in the ballot storage box and sealed with strip tie 0329074 and two paper seals.
