

2023 DOG LICENSES

Massachusetts General Law Chapter 140 Section 137 requires all dogs over the age of six months to be licensed. You may renew online, by mail (use form below) or drop box located in the parking lot. Current rabies certificates must be on file in the Town Clerk's office before licenses can be issued.

Licenses must be renewed before June 1st to avoid late fees and fines.

Please notify the Town Clerk if your dog has passed or moved.
