

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
TOWN OF WHATELY
March 27, 2019**

Pursuant to the recorded warrant a special town meeting of the Town of Whately held at the Whately Town Offices, 4 Sandy Lane was called to order Wednesday, March 27, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. by Moderator Richard Smith. Town Clerk, Lynn Sibley, read the return of the warrant. 14 voters were checked in.

ARTICLE 1: Upon motion made and seconded, it was

Voted that the town, pursuant to G.L. c. 44B, appropriate and transfer from the Community Preservation Fund Unreserved Fund Balance \$50,000.00, to make an additional payment on the one year note for the Town Hall Rehabilitation Project.

Moderator declared article passed unanimously.

ARTICLE 2. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

Voted that the town, pursuant to G.L. c. 44B, appropriate and transfer from the Community Preservation Fund Unreserved Fund Balance \$550.00 to pay for the issuance costs of a one year note for the Town Hall Historic Rehabilitation Project.

Moderator declared article passed unanimously.

ARTICLE 3. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

Voted that the town transfer the sum of \$500.00 from Fiscal Year 2018 Free Cash to pay the unpaid longevity bonus of a town employee from the past two fiscal years (FY2017 and FY2018).

9/10th vote required. Moderator declared article passed unanimously.

Motion was made to adjourn without date at 7:03 p.m. – Vote was unanimous.
