## ARTICLE 1: Upon motion made and seconded, it was

**Voted** that the town, pursuant to G.L. c. 44B, appropriate and transfer from the Community Preservation Fund Unreserved Fund Balance \$50,000.00, to make an additional payment on the one year note for the Town Hall Rehabilitation Project.

Moderator declared article passed unanimously.

## ARTICLE 2. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

**Voted** that the town, pursuant to G.L. c. 44B, appropriate and transfer from the Community Preservation Fund Unreserved Fund Balance \$550.00 to pay for the issuance costs of a one year note for the Town Hall Historic Rehabilitation Project.

Moderator declared article passed unanimously.

## ARTICLE 3. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

**Voted** that the town transfer the sum of \$500.00 from Fiscal Year 2018 Free Cash to pay the unpaid longevity bonus of a town employee from the past two fiscal years (FY2017 and FY2018).

9/10<sup>th</sup> vote required. Moderator declared article passed unanimously.
