Annual Election – June 9, 2020

Election workers included a person to ask health related questions, a person to manage the social distancing of the voters, a check in person, a check out person, a warden who managed the ballot box, the constable, Clerk and a person to wipe down voting booths after voters voted.

At the opening of the polls, and before any ballots were cast, the Ballot Box register indicated 000 and was declared empty; and at the close of the polls the Ballot Box register indicated 208. There were 1208 voters eligible to vote in this election. The officers in charge of the voting lists counted and announced the whole number of names checked on said list to be 208. presiding officer then removed the ballots from the box and caused them to be counted one by one, and announced the whole number of ballots cast to be 208. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic the legislature voted to allow early voting by mail for municipal elections for this year. Included in the count were 8 absentee ballots. One hundred eighty-eight early voting ballots were requested and 165 were returned. Eight absentee ballots were requested and all were returned by the close of polls. Two early voting ballots were rejected because the envelope was There were no provisional ballots. The ballots having been duly sorted and counted were recorded and declared in open meeting to be as set forth in the official record. All Ballots were placed in a storage box and sealed with 1 yellow zip strip #0190259 and a label. Count was completed at 7:30 p.m.
