## SPECIAL TOWN MEETING TOWN OF WHATELY July 31, 2019

Pursuant to the recorded warrant a special town meeting of the Town of Whately held at the Whately Town Offices, 4 Sandy Lane was called to order Wednesday, July 31, 2019 at 7:01 p.m. by Moderator Richard Smith. Town Clerk, Lynn Sibley, read the return of the warrant. 12 voters were checked in.

## ARTICLE 1: Motion made and seconded to:

**Moved** that the Town vote, pursuant to G.L. c. 44B, to appropriate and transfer the sum of \$62,127 from the Community Preservation Fund Unreserved Fund Balance for the construction and development of a softball field at Herlihy Park.

A friendly amendment was made and seconded to:

Amend the article to read as follows: That the Town vote, pursuant to G.L. c. 44B, to appropriate and transfer the sum of \$61,300 from the Community Preservation Fund Budgeted Reserves for the construction and development of a softball field at Herlihy Park.

The following vote on the amendment was then taken:

It was voted that the Town amend the article to read as follows: That the Town vote, pursuant to G.L. c. 44B, to appropriate and transfer the sum of \$61,300 from the Community Preservation Fund Budgeted Reserves for the construction and development of a softball field at Herlihy Park.

Then the original article was voted on as amended as follows:

Voted that the Town, pursuant to G.L. c. 44B, appropriate and transfer the sum of \$61,300 from the Community Preservation Fund Budgeted Reserves for the construction and development of a softball field at Herlihy Park.

Moderator declared article passed unanimously.

Clerk's Note: Amendment made to adjust total appropriation and the original proposed source of funding was not presently available.

## ARTICLE 2. Upon motion made and seconded, it was

**Voted** that the town repurpose \$3,000 of unexpended funds appropriated under Article 15 of the April 26, 2016 Annual Town Meeting to include the construction and development of a softball field at Herlihy Park.

Moderator declared article passed unanimously.

Clerk's Note: Article 15 pertains to money appropriated to build a shed at the Blue School, 219 Christian Lane. With the sale of the property this shed is no longer needed.

Motion was made to adjourn without date at 7:07 p.m. - Vote was unanimous.
